

Wisdom in the Waiting

Scripture:

“If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God... and it will be given to you.”

— James 1:5 (NIV)

Devotional:

Waiting isn't easy — especially when the decision feels urgent. But wisdom rarely shows up in a rush. It's in the pause, the prayer, the stillness before the next step. We live in a world that praises instant answers, fast fixes, and quick turnarounds. But God's wisdom doesn't always come with speed. It comes with stillness. And that stillness is where your heart gets aligned with His.

Asking for wisdom is one thing. Waiting on it is another. But Scripture reminds us that God gives wisdom generously to those who ask — and He's never late with His answer. If you're in a season of waiting, remember: it's not wasted. It's the place where God is preparing your heart to walk in the light, not just the logic.

Prayer:

Lord, I want Your wisdom more than a quick fix.
Help me wait well — with trust, patience, and peace.
Teach me to pause before I act, and to listen before I speak.
Thank You for being faithful in every step — even the slow ones.
