Ephesians 3:16–17 (NIV):

“I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love...”

In a world full of shifting opinions and unstable ground, being rooted in truth is more important than ever. God doesn't want us tossed around by every new trend or overwhelmed by every hardship—we were created to stand firm in His love and truth.
